## **2007 SPRING SPORTS PROGRAMS**

Registration for Tee ball, girls' softball, and Little League will be BY MAIL only. All children MUST BE registered members of the Hillcrest Community Youth Department in order to participate in any of these sports programs. We are enclosing HCYD membership registration forms. Return all forms (membership, emergency medical, and sports registration) with appropriate payment to the Young Israel office.

### **Jewish Community Little League**

Little League Registration is open to children in grades 3 through 8. There are three divisions in Little League, a preppie for children in grades 3 and 4, a junior for children in grades 5 and 6, and an intermediate for children in grades 7 and 8. Little League rules for the junior and intermediate divisions limit the number of players on a team to 12. For everyone's benefit, and to ensure that the kids have a good time, we will try to limit the number of players on the preppie team to 12 as well.

Little League registration is \$100.00 per child of families who are members of the Young Israel of Hillcrest, Torah Center of Hillcrest, Utopia Torah Congregation or Congregation Ohr Moshe. Registration is \$120.00 per child of families who are not members of any of these shuls. Early-bird registrations are \$80 and \$100, respectively.

### **Girls' Softball**

Girls' softball registration is open for girls in grades 3 through 8. There will be two divisions, a junior for girls in grades 3 through 5 and a senior for girls in grades 6 through 8. We will be limiting the number of players on each team to 12.

Registration is **\$65.00** for members of the Young Israel of Hillcrest, Torah Center of Hillcrest, Utopia Torah Congregation or Congregation Ohr Moshe and **\$85.00** for non-members. Early-bird registrations are \$50 and \$70, respectively.

### **Tee Ball**

Tee ball registration is open for boys and girls in grades 1 and 2. Registration is **\$65.00** for members of the Young Israel of Hillcrest, Torah Center of Hillcrest, Utopia Torah Congregation or Congregation Ohr Moshe and **\$85.00** for non-members. Early-bird registrations are \$50 and \$70, respectively.
